With the objective of attainment of Sustainable Development Goals of United Nations by 2030, the Gram Panchayats, Panchayat Samitis and Zilla Parishads of West Bengal formulated comprehensive and qualitative LSDG-Theme based Panchayat Development Plans in the last two (02) years. However, as per approved plan uploaded in the eGramSwaraj Portal it has been noticed that most of the Gram Panchayats had given emphasis on Self-sufficient Infrastructure Theme-6 (74%) and to some extent on Clean & Green Theme-5 (10%) & Water sufficiency Theme-4 (8%). Only a few GPs had taken "Sankalp" on rest 6 LSDG Themes viz. Poverty-free Theme-1, Healthy Theme-2, Child-friendly Theme-3, Socially Secure Theme-7 and Good governance Theme-8. No GP selected Women-friendly Theme-9 as "Sankalp".

Now, in order to bring a parity and holistic development with equitable distribution of "Sankalp" amongst the Gram Panchayats, Panchayats and Rural Department has felt it necessary that a minimum number of Gram Panchayats shall select specific themes as "Sankalp".

Under these circumstances, it is necessary to take the following steps:

- 1. Motivate the Gram Panchayats and Panchayat Samitis to take up "Sankalp" amongst these six (06) themes on rotational basis
- Maximum two (02) LSDG Themes can be taken up together as "Sankalp" in a particular year. 25% of activities available under the "Sankalp" Theme have to be taken up and 25% of allocation under all untied fund (including untied portions of 15th FC, SFC, full OSR etc.) has to be earmarked for each LSDG Theme.
- 3. In this regard stakeholder line Departments shall nominate one Nodal Officer and share tentative budget for 2025-26 along with an action plan detailing activities which will be taken up (such as supply of materials, conducting awareness programmes, etc.) based on experience of previous two years.
- 4. It is suggested that the same "Sankalp" Theme is adopted by all Gram Panchayats of one Block.
- 5. It is also necessary to adopt a "Model" village based on these Themes. At a later stage, these Model villages may act as Learning centres for others.
- 6. Participation of all stakeholders in District, Block and Gram Panchayat workshop and planning process.
- 7. Presence of District level Officers in the meetings of Gram Panchayat, Gram Sabha and Para Baithaks.

In order to ensure more qualitative LSDG-Theme based Panchayat Development Plans for the Financial year 2025-26, convergence with concerned line Departments is essential.

Your monitoring and supervision is solicited in this regard.

Introduction

Preparation of Panchayat Development Plan entails prioritization of localized SDG (LSDG) Themes as "Sankalp" by each Gram Panchayat. Experience of last two years (average) reveals that:

- 92% GPs have taken "Sankalp" on 3 LSDG Themes on Infrastructure (74%), Clean & Green (10%) & Water sufficiency (8%) (Theme-6, 5 & 4 respectively)
- 8% GPs have taken "Sankalp" on rest 6 LSDG Themes which includes Poverty-free, Healthy, Child-friendly, Social Security, Good governance and Women-friendly (Theme-1,2,3,7, 8 & 9 respectively)
- Sankalp taken is being modified at a later stage.

The State need to focus on more important aspects of human development. United Nations SDG target year is 2030 by which it is expected that all Themes should be covered. It is also necessary to adopt a Model village based on Priority Theme (Sankalp) such as "one Women friendly village" in each district.

Only 25% of allocation under all untied fund (including untied portions of 15th FC, SFC, full OSR etc.) has to be earmarked for any LSDG Theme taken as Sankalp. 2 (two) LSDG Themes can be taken up together as Sankalp by any GP in a particular year and this will require 50% of untied fund in total. Each LSDG Theme has 30-40 earmarked activities and only 25% of those activities have to be taken up to take a Sankalp. Many of the activities focus on "awareness generation" or taken up by the line Departments as Regular activity, e.g. distribution of iron tablets among pregnant women. Each Theme has at least 4/5 activities which need infrastructure generation to create tangible assets. The balance 50% of the united fund can be used for other regular activities in addition to the tied fund. Therefore, no regular development work will be hampered.

Role of Self-Help Groups especially Upasangha and Sangha is necessary as VPRP prepared by the SHGs shall provide very important inputs for the Plan. Schemes proposed in VPRP will be embedded in the Plan.

Following steps are being taken up for preparation of more qualitative development plan:

- A State level workshop with key personnel like Joint Block Development Officers, Block Informatics Officers (BIO), ISGP Co-ordinators/ Mentors, STARPARD Trainers, Software Support Personnel (SSP), etc. to roll out training and sensitization activities.
- The stakeholder Departments may be requested to Nominate one Nodal Officer at the State & District levels and share tentative fund for 2025-26 with their counterpart at districts.
- District level training of Facilitator-cum-Charge Officers (FCCO) & Pradhan of all Gram Panchayats.

- GP level General Body meeting with all line department officials in presence of BDO /Jt. BDO.
- Hand holding Training of Technical persons of GP on uploading of plan in eGramSwaraj portal.
- Presence of District level Officers in the meetings of Gram Panchayat, Gram Sabha and Para Baithaks.

Initiatives of Panchayati Raj Institutions as well as co-ordination with stakeholder line departments during the planning process is essential for formulation of a proper Panchayat Development Plan.

Concept of Panchayat Development Plan (PDP)

Q: What do you mean by Panchayat Development Plan?

Ans: In the context of development, planning means structured thinking and working out a system indicating steps, stages and processes in which development can take place. Preparation of proper plan is essential for development. Vision of development planning is that the common people will take active part in planning process and others are just facilitators of planning process. In other wards common people are the primary stakeholders of planning process.

Q: What should be the vision of development planning?

Ans: In the context of planning & development, Gram Panchayats need to have a clear vision i.e. the capacity to visualize what they want to achieve through planned interventions. Focus & priority to be given on social development like Education, Public Health, Nutrition, Child Development, Livelihood Expansion, development of marginalised sections along with development of infrastructure. In social sector, '0' (zero) based targeting should be fixed for achievement through development planning. For example, number of school dropouts will be zero, number of non-institutional delivery will be zero, number of girls got married below 18 years of age, number of women become mother before the age of 21 will be zero, number of anaemic women will be zero, number of incidence of woman & child trafficking will be zero, etc.

Q: Why specific goals and initiatives are essential in planning?

Ans: For appropriate planning, envisioning i.e. developing a concrete vision for achieving certain goals is essentially required i.e. realistically what development Gram Panchayats want to achieve. In planning, vision is to be supplemented with goal setting and setting specific objectives. It is essentially important to set local development goals in tune with the Sustainable Development Goals [SDGs]. Along with 193 countries, India is also a signatory and committed to achieve 17 SDGs by 2030 with focus on poverty alleviation, education, public health, nutrition, gender equality, etc. Towards sustainable development thrust is given onn the economic, social & environment sectors. For localization of these sustainable development goals at Panchayat levels, these 17 SDGs have been converged into nine SDG Themes, interlinked & inter dependent. These nine SDG Themes are as follows :

Theme 1 : Poverty Free Livelihood enhanced Gram Panchayat

Theme 2 : Healthy Gram Panchayat

Theme 3 : Child Friendly Gram Panchayat

Theme 4 : Water Sufficient Gram Panchayat

Theme 5: Clean and Green Gram Panchayat

Theme 6 : Gram Panchayat with Self Sufficient Infrastructure

Theme 7 : Social Justice and Socially Secured Gram Panchayat

Theme 8 : Gram Panchayat with Good Governance

Theme 9 : Women Friendly Gram Panchayat

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Q : What is the main Objective of Panchayat Planning ?

Ans: The main objectives of Panchayats planning is to "achieve economic development and social justice in the area". To this end, and towards localization of SDGs Gram Panchayats have to adopt thematic approach in planning and take Sankalpa on specific theme to achieve in a time bound manner based on local needs, development gaps & priorities. Based on the theme taken as Sankalpa, Gram Panchayats have to set specific objectives, plan activities for achieving those objectives and implement activities towards achieving those objectives.

Q : How Gram Panchayats will select specific theme as Sankalpa ?

Ans :

- While planning, Gram Panchayats must select & adopt at least one but not more than two Themes out of the nine SDG-Themes as Sankalpa based on local needs, development gaps & priorities
- The adopted resolution must be uploaded on the Vibrant Gram Sabha Portal (https://meetingonline.gov.in/).
- Based on the resolution adopted on the SDG theme, Gram Panchayats have to select and finalize 25% of the activities from the listed works under the respective theme (s) taken as Sankalpa

Q : What are the key aspects that the GPs have to consider while formulating plan ?

Ans : While formulating plan, GPs have to consider following key aspects :

- Give due importance to all nine SDG Themes.
- Plan activities to remove local economic/ social/ political/ gender and other disparities.
- Take initiatives to protect the basic fundamental rights of the backward/ marginalized section.
- Take initiatives for overall development of the area, especially human development such as education, health, nutrition, and livelihood expansion by utilizing natural resources and other available resources.
- Planning to develop infrastructure considering its sustainability & utility aspects so that it becomes remunerative assets of Gram Panchayats.
- Activity to be planned and implemented in such a way so that it does not have any adverse/ negative impact on the environment.
- Take initiatives for conservation & protection of local biodiversity & eco-system and work towards creating environment-friendly Gram Panchayats.
- Empower women by engaging them in various development interventions, focus on health & nutrition aspects of women & children, take initiatives to create child-friendly Gram Panchayats & joyful learning environment for children.

Q : What is institutional arrangements at different levels in formulating Panchayat

Development Plans?

Ans: At district level:

- The Additional Executive Officer (ZP) / Additional District Magistrate (Panchayat) leads at district level.
- The District Panchayats & Rural Development Officer functions as District Nodal Officer.
- Other district level officers and trainers impart training and facilitate, coordinate & monitor entire planning process.

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At Block Level

- Block Development Officer (BDO) leads at block level
- Joint Block Development Officer (Jt. BDO) functions as Block Nodal Officer.
- Other Extension Officers at Block Level is appointed as Facilitator Cum Charge Officer and provide guidance and support to the Gram Panchayat Planning Facilitating Team (GPPFT) and work as Trainers in different stages and extend support towards successful accomplishment of the planning process.

At Gram Panchayat (GP) Level

- For planning at Gram Panchayat Level, Pradhan, Upa-Pradhan, Executive Assistant and Secretary take lead role.
- All Elected Representatives & Employees of Gram Panchayat are actively involved and take initiatives in preparation and implementation of GPDP.
- Gram Panchayat Planning Facilitation Team (GPPFT) provide support and ensure participation of people in Planning Process.

Q: What are the Roles & Responsibilities of Different Levels in PDP?

Ans :

At District Level

- Regular interaction/ coordination with Block Level and monitoring of planning process
- Regular monitoring of the e-Gram Swaraj uploading.
- Keeping contact with the concerned Line Departments.

At Block Level

- Regular contact & follow-up with Gram Panchayats.
- Regular monitoring of Gram Panchayat activities.

At Gram Panchayat Level

• Regular interaction/ meetings with the Gram Panchayat Planning Facilitation Team (GPPFT) and Frontline Workers, phase wise statutory meetings and progress monitoring.

Q : What are the Financial Resources for Gram Panchayat Development Plan (GPDP)?


Ans :

- Own Source Revenue (OSR) of Gram Panchayat- Untied Fund.
- Fifth State Finance Commission Grant (SFC Grant)- Untied Fund.
- Swachh Bharat Mission-Gramin (SBM-G)- Tied Fund.
- Fifteenth Central Finance Commission Grant (CFC Grant)- both Tied Fund & Untied Fund.
 - 60% of 15th CFC Grant is tied fund and out of this tied fund, 50% may be utilized for Drinking Water and the rest 50% may be utilized for Sanitation.
 - From the untied fund the Gram Panchayat will use minimum 25% funds for activities taken as per their themes taken as Sankalpa & the rest funds can be used for other thematic activities.

Q: What are the steps for preparation of Panchayat Development Plan, 2025-26 under PPC, 2024 ?

Ans : Following steps are to be followed for PDP, 2025-26 -

- 1. Roll out of PPC 2024-25 by MoPR, Gol.
- 2. Appointment of Nodal Officers (State/ District/ Block level) and their User Creation in GPDP Portal (gpdp.nic.in)

State- Member Secretary, STARPARD, P&RD Department

District – District Panchayat & Rural Development Officer

Block- Joint Block Development Officer

- 3. Engagement & user creation of Facilitator-cum-Charge Officer (FCCO)
 - a. One for each GP/ PS/ ZP. In case of GP, Extension Officers of Block are engaged as FCCO.
 - b. For PS, PDO/PAAO/ Deputy Secretary.
 - c. For ZP, Secretary, Zilla Parishad /Deputy Secretary, Zilla Parishad.
 - d. User creation of FCCO for GP is done by Block Nodal Officer, for PS is done by District Nodal Officer and for ZP is done by State Nodal Officer.
- 4. Engagement and entry of details of Front-Line Workers (Line Department Officials) in GPDP portal. For GP, Block Nodal Officer enters the details, for PS, District Nodal Officer and for ZP, State Nodal Officer.
- 5. District level Workshop to be organised for preparation of Panchayat Development Plan.
- 6. District level Training Programme to be organised for Pradhan & FCCO of Gram Panchayats.
- 7. Formation of Gram Panchayat Planning Facilitation Team (GPPFT) for GP and Sectoral Working Group (SWG) for PS & ZP.
- 8. Joint Meeting will be organised with GPPFT in presence of BDO / Jt. BDO / FCCO at Gram Panchayat level.
- Scheduling of 1st Gram Sabha/ PS Sabha/ ZP Sabha in GP Portal by BNO/ DNO/ SNO respectively.
- 10. After Sabha is conducted, details (Sabha Feedback Form in GPDP Portal & Sabha image, Sabha resolution, Public Information Board image) is uploaded by FCCO in GPDP Portal.

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In addition to this, Gram Panchayat shall upload Live video of Gram Sabha in GS NIRNAY app, and Resolution of Sabha in Vibrant Gram Sabha Portal (meetingonline.gov.in). GPs are also required to select at least one (maximum-two) Sankalpa from nine LSDG themes.

- 11. Collection of Data on nine LSDG themes by organizing Para Baithaks and compilation & analysis of the data by GP.
- 12. Preparation and adoption of draft plan by GP.

[Preparation of the outline / draft annual plan & budget for the F. Y. 2025-26 and approval of annual plan & budget for the Financial Year 2025-26 will be executed in different phase wise meetings as mentioned in the existing rules]

- 13. Sishu Sabha & Mahila Sabha (for GP only)
- 14. Gram Sansad Meetings (for GP only)






